Our role

We are sponsoring the year 8 class, which is the examination class in Karai School. It has 80 students all in one room not much bigger than our larger English/Maths room. The students study 5 subjects:

English, Maths, Science, Cre and Kiswahili with only 1 text book for each subject shared between 4 students. Our goal this year is to ensure that all students in year 8 have enough text books for 1 between 2 for all 5 subjects.



So far we have raised £417 which has bought 23 text books for English and 23 text books for maths. We hope to raise enough by Easter to complete the purchase of 23 Science books.
